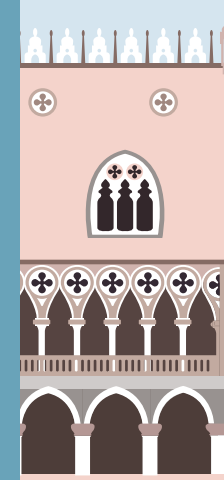

Contemporary Art & Curatorship: from documenta to the Biennale

This full-time Summer School provides students a unique insight into the management of the world's most renowned contemporary art exhibitions, with particular focus on La Biennale di Venezia.

The programme will alternate in-class learning activities with on-site visits to selected venues of the 19th International Architecture Exhibition (international exhibition, national pavilions, collateral events) and with visits to historical venues of Fondazione La Biennale di Venezia.

OUR COURSES

Geopolitics and Geostrategy

This course maps how differing approaches to geopolitics shape our understanding of risk and insecurity, and the strategies designed to counter them, and how our traditional understanding of war, conflict and risk has been fundamentally transformed over the past century.

Fees: €400

AI, Cyberthreats and Cyberspies

This course talks about how AI is transforming cognitive warfare and propaganda, and what the emergence of new forms of cyber war, cyberespionage and surveillance, along with the changing role of AI within national security, means for cybersecurity.

Water, Art, and Archaeology

This course investigates the ways water has shaped human experience across time and space through its function as a mediator in art, architecture and archaeology, using Venice and its lagoon as a case study.

Environmental Humanities: a view from Venice

This course focuses on how humanistic knowledge, in dialogue with the natural and social sciences, can interpret and address the immense environmental challenges facing our planet through the lens of the uniquely resilient yet vulnerable city of Venice.

Critical issues in tourism

This course explores current trends and critical issues in contemporary tourism, in particular its sustainability given its environmental, social and economic implications, and how this can be seen in Venice: one of the world's most iconic tourist destinations.

Venetian Art History

This course introduces Italian Art History through the lens of Venice's history. It focuses on the analysis of key artworks and artists, offering a deeper understanding of the city's cultural significance and the myth of Venice.

Fees: €400

Beginner Italian language

A beginner Italian course (at the A1 level) aimed at providing students with basic language functions for simple and effective communication in the Italian language within a variety of contexts.
